## 應用經濟與社會發展英語碩士學位學程之雙主修、輔系修業規定

民國 113 年 11 月 15 日 第 73 次學程委員會會議通過

民國 113 年 12 月 16 日 113 學年度第 1 學期第 2 次教務會議通過

- 第一條 本修業規定依國立政治大學碩博士班學生修讀雙主修、輔系辦法訂定之。
- 第二條 在本校就讀應用經濟與社會發展英語碩士學位學程(以下簡稱應社碩)以外的碩博士班學生自註冊在學第二學期起至第四學期止，依校訂行事曆規定日期，向應社碩提出雙主修或輔系的申請。學生修讀雙主修或輔系，應依核准開始修讀學年度該學系之修課及學分採計規定辦理。
- 第三條 經應社碩核准修讀雙主修的學生，必須符合以下條件才能達到取得雙主修學位之資格。
- (一) 學生至少應修習應社碩的課程共二十五學分；學生可以專案提出抵免學分申請，由應社碩學程委員會判定，至多得抵免十二學分，其中以中文授課課程的學分數至多可抵免九學分。
  - (二) 學生須以英文撰寫碩士論文並通過學位考試。
- 第四條 經應社碩核准修讀輔系的學生，必須符合以下條件才能達到取得輔系之資格。學生至少應修習應社碩的課程共二十二學分；學生可以專案提出抵免學分申請，由應社碩學程委員會判定，至多得抵免十一學分，其中以中文授課課程的學分數至多可抵免九學分。
- 第五條 本修業規定如有未規定之事宜，悉依本校學則、有關法令、以及碩博士班學生修讀雙主修、輔系辦法之規定辦理。
- 第六條 本修業規定經教務會議審議通過後發布施行，修正時亦同。

### Regulations for Double Major and Minor for the International Master's Program of Applied Economics and Social Development (IMES)

Approved by the 73<sup>rd</sup> IMES Committee Meeting on November 15, 2024

Approved by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Academic Affairs Meeting of the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester, Academic Year 113 on December 16, 2024

#### Article 1

These regulations are formulated in accordance with the National Chengchi University Regulations Governing Master's and Doctoral Students Taking Double Majors and Minors.

#### Article 2

Students enrolled in graduate programs other than the Master's Program in Applied Economics and Social Development (hereafter referred to as "IMES") at NCCU may apply for a double major or minor starting from the second semester of their enrollment through the fourth semester, according to the university's academic calendar. The application must be submitted to the IMES. Students pursuing a double major or minor are required to follow the curriculum and credit regulations of the respective department or program for the academic year they begin their studies.

#### Article 3

Students who have been approved by the IMES to pursue a double major must meet the following conditions in order to qualify for a double major degree:

1. Students must complete at least 25 credits of courses in the IMES. Students may apply for credit exemptions on a case-by-case basis, subject to review by the IMES Committee. A maximum of 12 credits may be exempted, with no more than 9 credits allowed for courses taught in Chinese.
2. Students must write their Master's thesis in English and pass the degree examination.

#### Article 4

Students who have been approved by the IMES to pursue a minor must meet the following conditions in order to qualify for a minor:

1. Students must complete at least 22 credits of courses in the IMES. Students may apply for credit exemptions on a case-by-case basis, subject to review by the IMES Committee.

A maximum of 11 credits may be exempted, with no more than 9 credits allowed for courses taught in Chinese.

**Article 5**

Any matters not addressed in these regulations shall be governed by the university's academic regulations, relevant laws and regulations, and the Regulations Governing Master's and Doctoral Students Taking Double Majors and Minors.

**Article 6**

These regulations shall take effect after approval by the Academic Affairs Committee. Any amendments shall be subject to the same approval process.
